So, below you will find just one item: A report and presentation I did in 2012, which tells the story of one of the epic battles in the West to not just build needed infrastructure, but how the project to build the Grand Coulee Dam in Washington State transformed the entire nation's economy, raising that economy to a new platform of productivity and uplifting the lives of millions of people.
